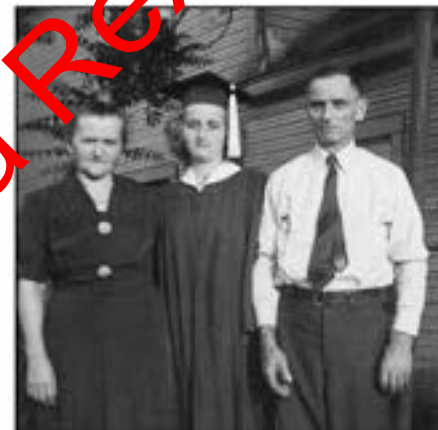

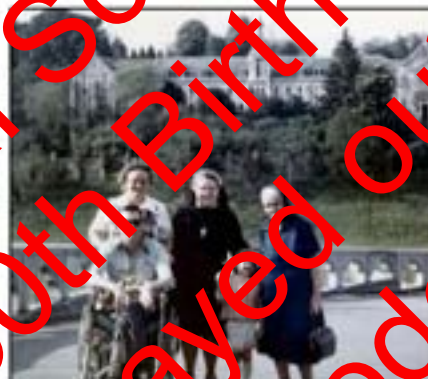

Maggie gave birth to a new daughter, Regina, who was born with serious birth defects. She had two holes in her heart, and parts of her insides were jumbled up or missing altogether. She underwent operation after operation. Her mother, a former nun, knew of no other way to raise a child with so many challenges than to raise her in faith and faith alone. It was not long through her mother. Then he spoke to the little girl directly, telling her that she was his child, and he had a plan for her. As a youngster, she watched her parents pray for her recovery in her bed, and she would hear her mother's prayers, she and her family would scrape together enough money to board a plane and fly across the world to Lourdes in France to pray and be healed by the healing Holy water of Guel. The sickly little girl would have walked in self pity. An only child, she could have become spoiled rotten and demanding, never caring in the word "no" during expecting to get her way, and in a sense, it is true. She doesn't understand the word "no..." because she carries a secret that she is born a sister first. "I wish I could see you in all things." 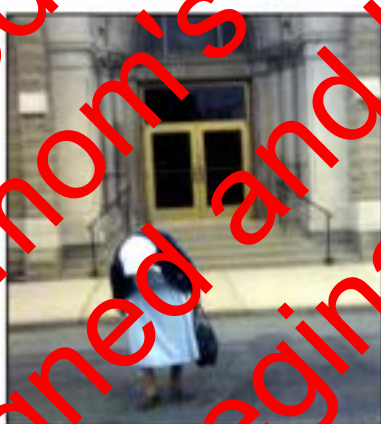

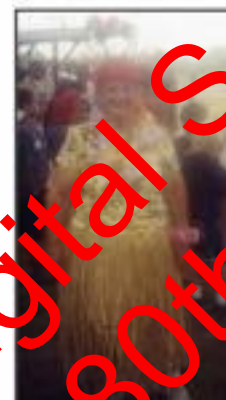

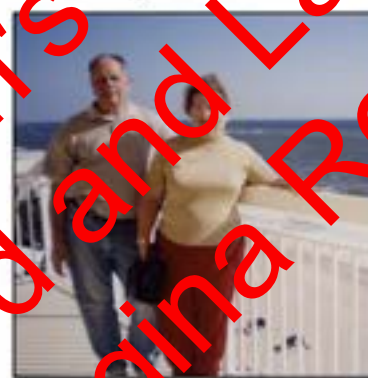
